Calculator Puzzles are a **fun** and **engaging** way for students to practice their math reasoning and computation skills.

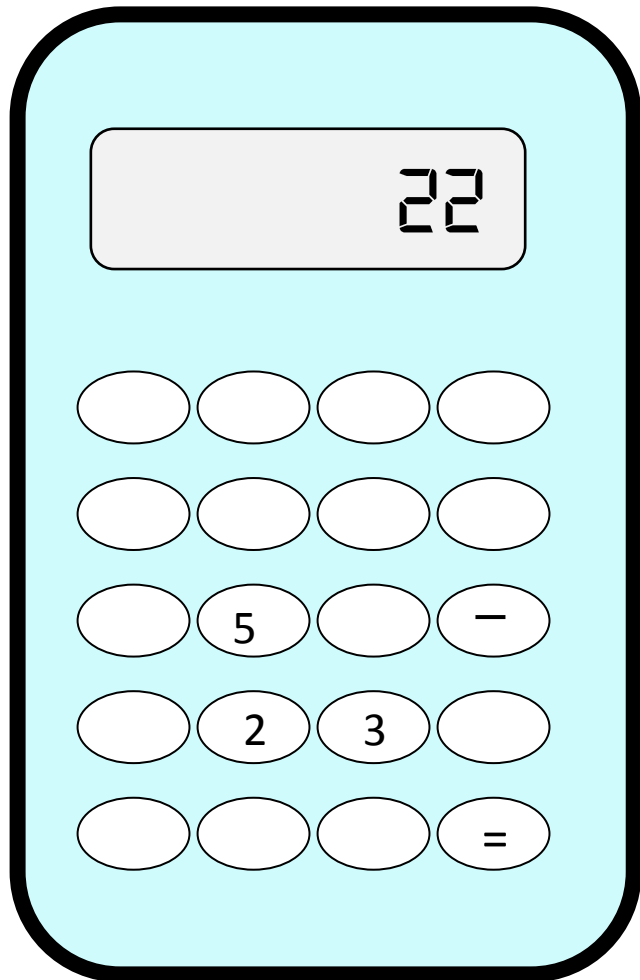
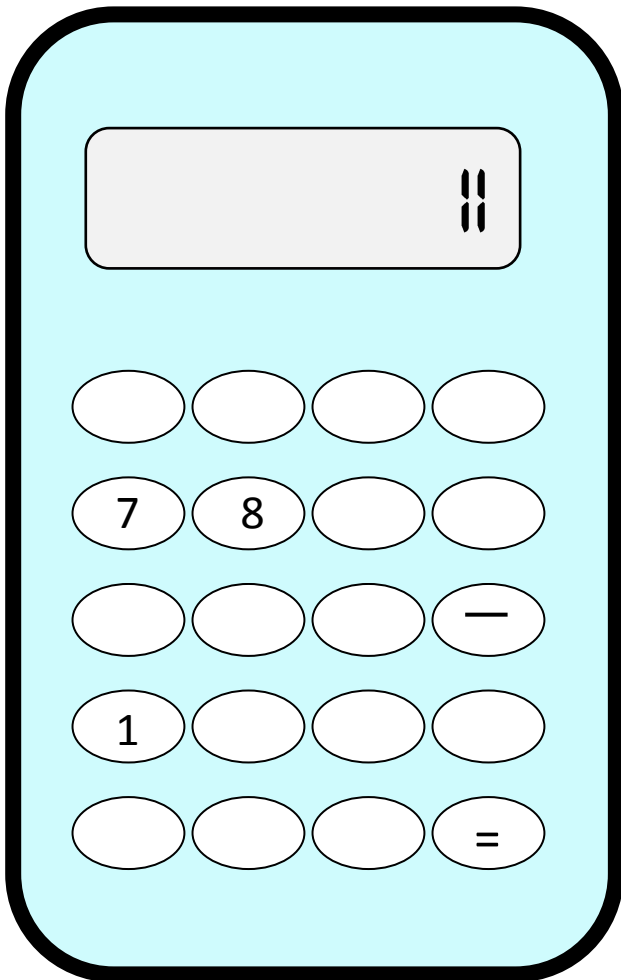
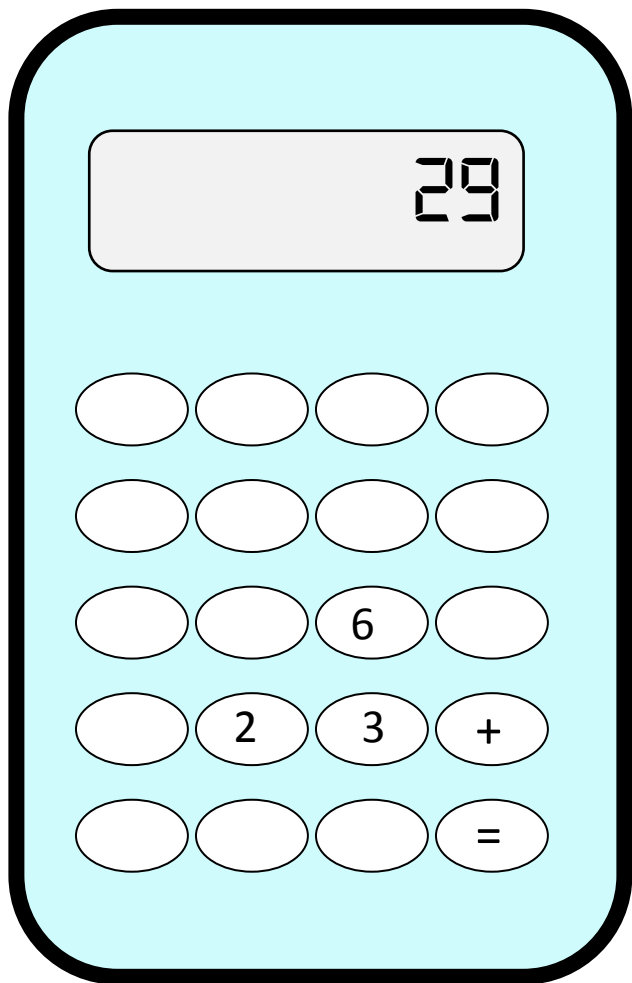
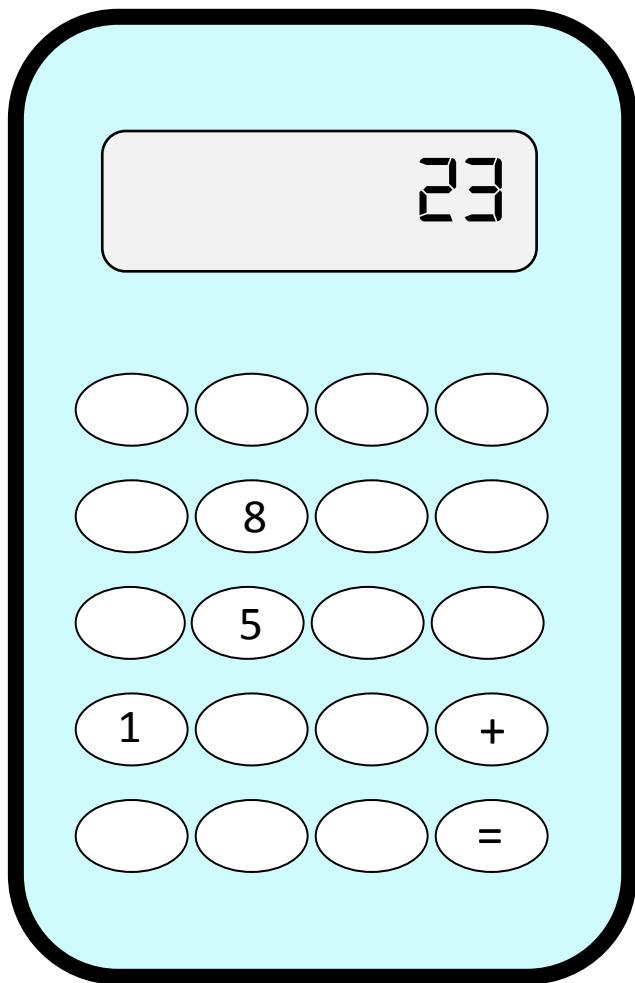
To use the Calculator Puzzles students must use **ALL** of the highlighted or shown digits and symbols to equal the number shown in the gray display.

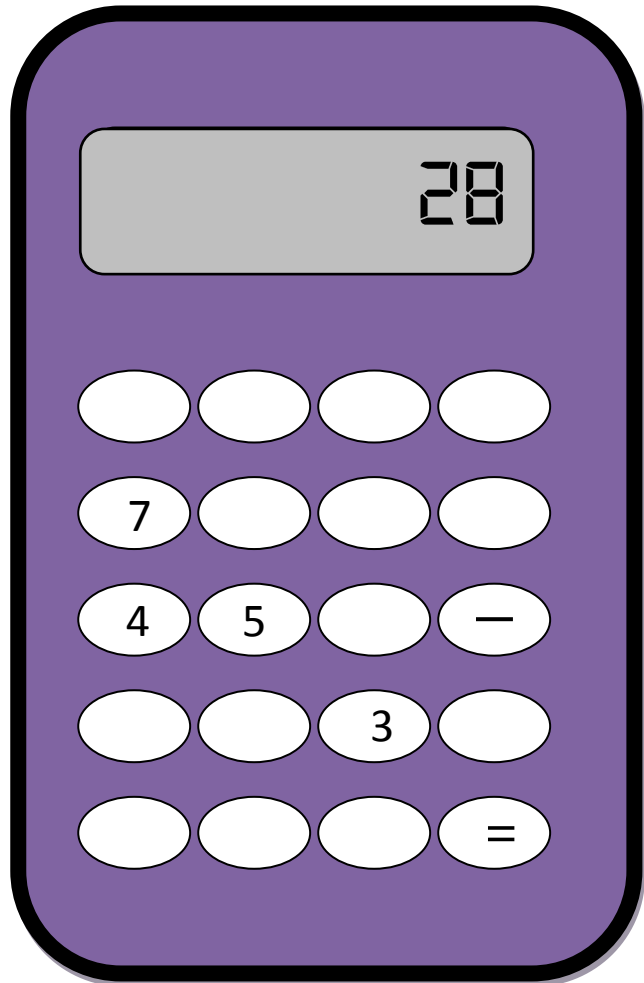
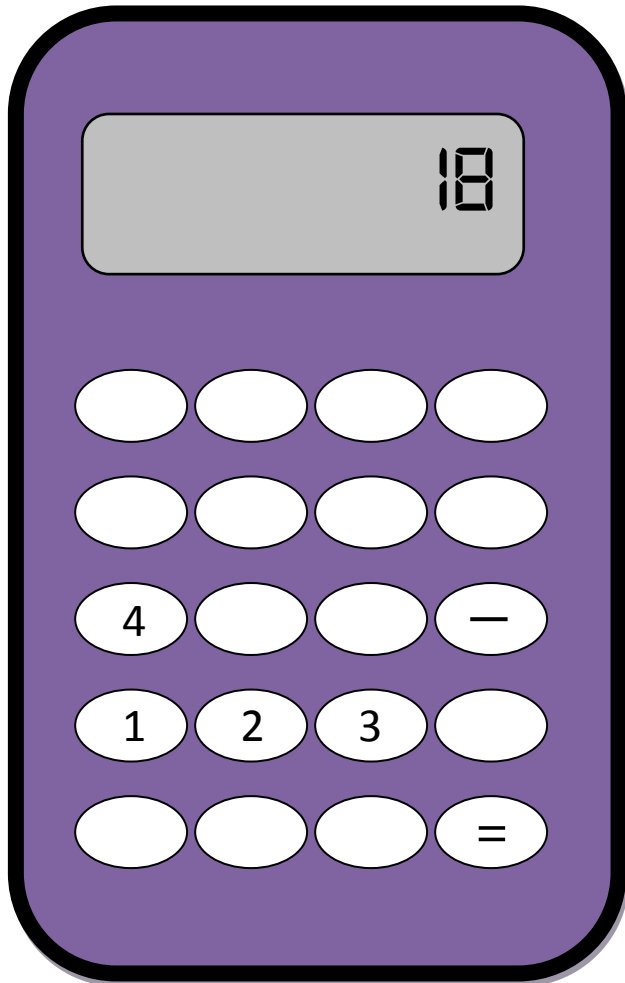
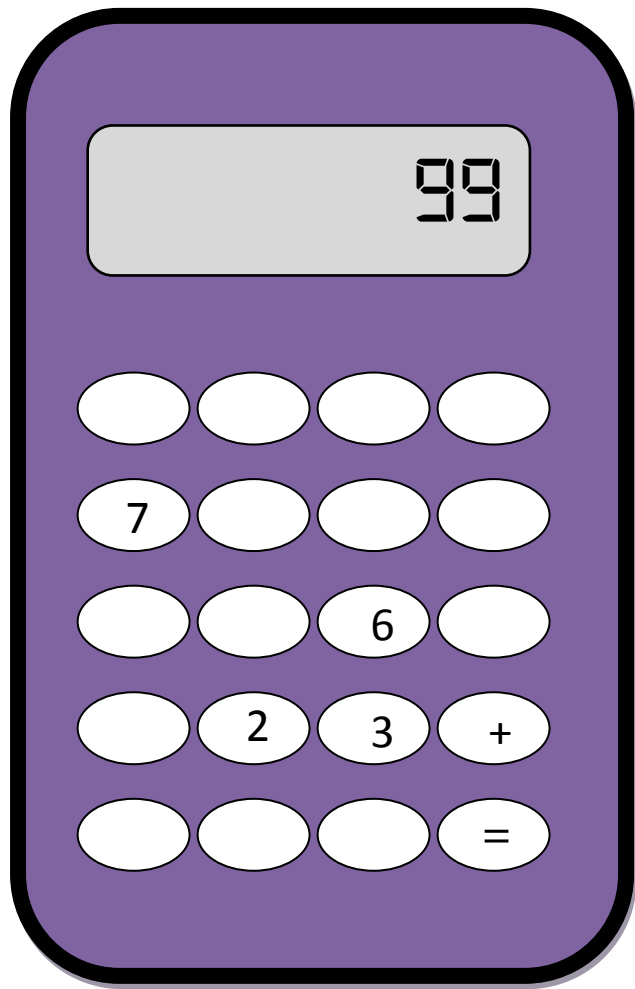
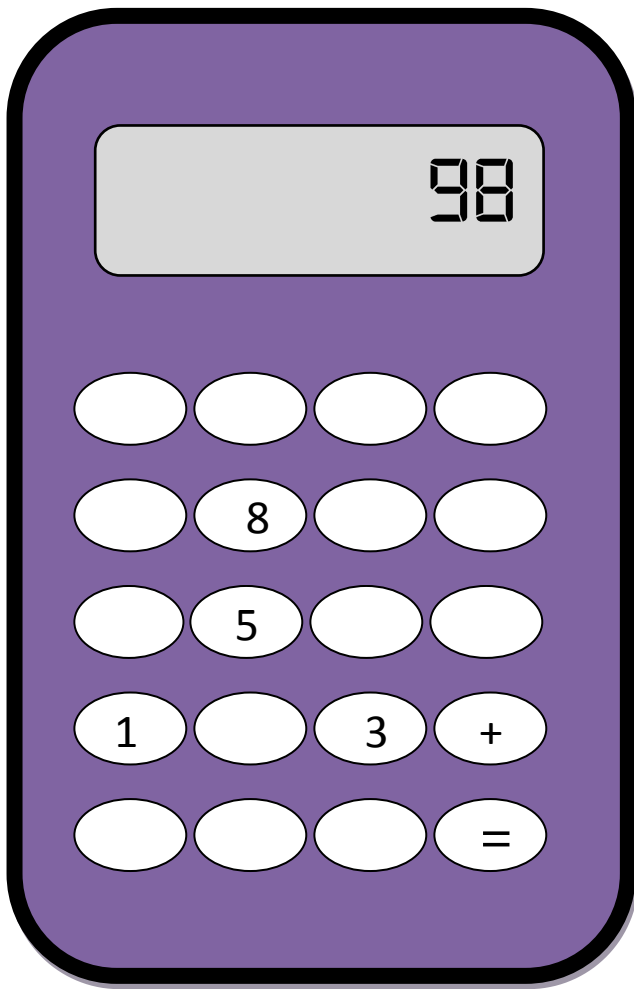
